DRAFTED COMMUNITY SURVEY –

Bill Foster from School Perceptions, LLC presented a drafted community survey. The survey is designed to gather demographic data, explain the campus-wide needs, and obtain the feedback of the public and staff around the potential referendum projects and associated costs/tax impact. The projects are categorized into the following topics: renovate classrooms/science labs, library media centers/large group instruction areas, design engineering manufacturing center, special education classrooms/student services, improve campus layout/site safety, update building infrastructure, replace swimming pool, expand gym, expand fine arts area, and land improvements.

The school board members, as well as representatives from Eppstein Uhen Architects and Miron Construction, discussed each page of the survey, making suggestions for several edits. The survey will be modified to include the improvements recommended during the discussion and then forwarded to the printing company. The survey is anticipated to arrive through the US mail to every household within the Arrowhead Union High School District during the first week of May.
