The meeting was called to order by President Rosch at 7:05 a.m. in the South Campus Cafeteria/All Purpose Room.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Rosch thanked the staff for their nonstop effort and hard work since March and in putting the reopening plan together.

Ms. Myrah presented the Arrowhead's Stay Safe to Stay Open-Reopening School Plan. The goal is to have in-person classes five days per week, along with a virtual five days per week learning option. However, the status of schools being open will depend on local health data which will be continually assessed. A major concern is attendance and mandatory quarantine as it relates to contact tracing of Covid-19. Close contact, as described by the CDC, is anyone within 6 ft. for more than 15 minutes. This may affect the attendance of both students as well as teaching staff. AHS will continue to work with the Waukesha County Reopening Schools Task Force and the Waukesha County Health Department regarding decisions and actions needed to maintain the safety of both students and staff.
