On this day in history, <u>December 7th, 1941</u>, the Japanese navy attacked American forces at Pearl Harbor among other locations in Hawaii. This attack led to the death of 2,403 service members and civilians. President Franklin D. Roosevelt gave a famous speech in which he referred to December 7th as the "day that will live in infamy." This day led to the United States' declaration of entering World War II, significantly altering the outcome of the war.
