A number of you took the 4th option and suggested that we look for an alternate indoor facility. Based on last year's graduation we would need a site that handled at least 4,000 people. I explored that option and I was not able to find a facility in Waukesha County that met our needs. I was able to find three sites in Milwaukee County that worked. The U.S. Cellular Arena was not available but the Milwaukee Theatre on the same site was open. The cost would be in the neighborhood of \$10,000.00 and would require people to pay for parking. The Bradley Center did not return my call, but I was told that they charge more than the Milwaukee Theatre. The 3rd site, is Miller Park, they cannot guarantee that the site would be available from year-to-year due to home game commitments.
