

# MICROSOFT MOVIE MAKER

- **IMAGES AND SOUNDS MUST BE SAVED IN USER SPACE BEFORE CONTINUING**
  - Save files in User Space *frequently*

## ADDING PICTURES

1. In the left-hand pane, under *Capture Video*:
  - Follow the *Import Pictures* link
  - Browse to select desired pictures from User Space
2. A thumbnail view of the picture will appear in the *Collection*
  - If a RED X appears, it means the file cannot be found
    - Double-click the X
    - Choose *Yes* in the pop-up window to locate and relink image file

## ADDING SOUND

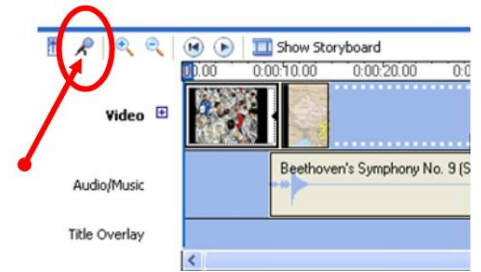
1. In the left-hand pane, under *Capture Video*:
  - Follow the *Import Audio or Music* link
  - Browse to select desired sounds/music from User Space
  - [soundzabound.com](http://soundzabound.com) has copyright free music
    - If using from home:
      - Username: arrowhead1
      - Password: hawks
2. A thumbnail view of the sound will appear in the *Collection*

## ADDING VIDEO FROM YOUTUBE

1. Find the desired Video on YouTube.
2. Use the *Download* option on the top right corner of the video screen
  - a. Choose the *Save Video As* Option
  - b. Browse to save video to the User Space
3. The *Real Player Converter* will open automatically
  - a. Select the video in the main screen so it is highlighted
  - b. Select the *Convert* option
  - c. Choose the *Select A Device* Drop-down menu
    - i. Find the *Video Format Option* on the drop down menu
    - ii. Select *.wmv* format
    - iii. Click *Ok*
  - d. Click *Start*
4. Save to User Space
5. File is now available to be imported into Movie Maker from the *Capture Video* Link
6. Video will be imported in small sections in order.
  - a. To add as one, drag each individually in the order as they appear

## ADDING NARRATION

1. Place the cursor in the desired area of the timeline
  - This is where the sound clip will appear once created
2. Select the microphone icon in the timeline toolbar
3. Connect microphone to computer using a USB
4. *Start Narration* to begin recording
5. *Stop Narration* when finished
6. Save to User Space



## CREATING VIDEO

1. Drag and drop desired files to the timeline in the desired order
  - This creates a split timeline with the sound on the bottom row
  - Adjust the volume and fade in or out
    - Select *Clip* on the main toolbar (top left of screen)
    - *Audio* has sound options
2. In the left-hand pane, under *Edit Movie*:
  - *View Video Transitions*
    - Drag and drop desired transition to the small connecting box between two clips
    - Preview this by using the *play button* on the timeline toolbar
3. In the left-hand pane, under *Finish Movie*:
  - *Save to My Computer*
  - Name Video and save in User Space
  - Click *Next*
  - Select *Best Quality for Playback on my Computer* and click *Next*
  - Click *Finish*
