Selection of the student to whom this scholarship will be awarded will be made by a committee representing the Waukesha Kennel Club, Inc. the committee will consider:

- ✓ Interest displayed in the field of biological science which includes, among others, human or veterinary medicine, genetics, science education, biochemistry, marine biology, forestry, agriculture, and wildlife management.
- ✓ Scholastic achievement, including standardized test scores and transcripts.
- ✓ Community standing as evidenced by personal references. Two letters of recommendation should accompany the application.

Completed applications should be submitted to your guidance counselor by **Friday, March 18, 2011** or mailed to the Waukesha Kennel Club Chairperson by Friday, March 25, 2011.

The recipient of this scholarship may re-apply to the Waukesha Kennel Club, Inc. annually for three years for additional grants of \$300.00 for the second year, \$700.00 for the third year and \$800.00 for the fourth year, for a possible total of \$2000.00.

The requirements for receiving these additional grants include:

- ✓ Continuing in biological science as a major field of study.
- ✓ Maintaining a 2.5 grade point (on a 4.0 basis) or its equivalent each school year.
- ✓ Re-applying prior to August 1.
