SPECIAL BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING  
WEDNESDAY, MARCH 10, 2021  
MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by President Rosch at 6:00 p.m. in the District Office Board Room.

Everyone rose for the Pledge of Allegiance.

The meeting was properly posted.

President Rosch reviewed the process to fill the vacant At Large Seat on the Arrowhead Board of Education, as per Board Policy/Procedure 113. Filling Board Vacancies. The board vacancy is a result of Dave Dean resigning from the position, who was re-elected to the At Large Seat on April 4, 2011, for a 3-year term. Mr. Rosch gave a brief description of the structure of the Arrowhead Board of Education and asked each board member to introduce themselves. The candidates interviewed by the Board of Education included: Christopher Farris and Laura Groomwald. Each candidate was given the opportunity to make an opening statement, answer predetermined interview questions, and provide a closing statement.

Following the conclusion of the candidate interviews, the Board of Education cast written ballot votes to appoint a candidate to fill the At Large Seat school board position vacancy until the next Spring Election in April 2022. Christopher Farris received the most votes as determined by a canvass of ballots cast: Christopher Farris - 5 votes: Laura Groomwald - 3 votes.

Mr. Farris may choose to run in the April 2022 Spring Election, and if elected, would serve the remaining one year of the unexpired term.

Mr. Farris will be seated on the Board upon taking the official oath.

Moved by Schultz, seconded by Hemmer to adjourn. Motion Carried.

The meeting adjourned at 6:42 p.m.
