

Students will have an adjusted schedule on Tuesday, March 2 to allow for Juniors to complete the required registration for the ACT.

**Freshmen, Sophomores** have an optional study hall from 7:20- 7:55 (SC). The First Hour will begin at 7:59 at SC.

**Seniors have a delayed start** as teachers at NC will be proctoring the ACT registration. First hour will begin at 8:09 at NC for Juniors and Seniors.

**Early enrollment 8th graders** who have first hour Geometry will meet at the normal time.

### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR JUNIORS:**

Juniors will be completing the required ACT test registration. Even if students have completed online ACT registration for a previous ACT test, this paper process is required for the state ACT test. This test registration is in preparation for the ACT test administered on March 9. Registration and testing will be held **IN PERSON**. Students attending Arrowhead virtually must attend in person.

- Juniors should report to testing rooms by 7:25 (this includes students with FSO).
- Testing room assignments will be posted outside of the North Campus Counseling Office beginning Friday, February 26, 2021. The room where Juniors report is the same room they will report to for testing on March 9. If you are a virtual learner, arrive early on March 2 and March 9 to be sure you know where to report.
- Students will need a **photo ID** and a **pencil** to complete the basic registration. All students must be wearing a **facemask** while in the building completing the registration.
- Students will be asked to remove their facemask for proper identification during the check in process. This is a requirement of ACT.
- Students will be given directions for how to complete the demographic information in MyACT. These directions include a specific student code unique to each student for logging into MyACT. Students and parents should review the directions carefully and complete this portion of the registration at home by March 11. This portion of the registration includes determining which colleges they would like scores sent to for free. Students who have already completed a profile in MyACT should NOT create an additional profile, but can review the previously entered information for accuracy or changes.
- Anyone who is absent or is quarantined on March 2 will need to make up registration ahead of the March 9 administration of the test.
- Students who are absent for March 9th test administration of the ACT will make up the test on March 23. This date is determined by the state of Wisconsin.
- Students are reminded that they can use METHOD TEST PREP to assist in preparation for the ACT. This tool is housed within your XELLO account.
- Juniors should stop into the Counseling Office if they have any questions.-- More specific information about the test will be sent after registration on March 2.
