

Arrowhead Enrollment/Course Selection Checklist

- ❑ If you have NOT done so, complete the NSOE (New Student Online Enrollment) form before January 30, 2026 to receive login and password info for the Course Selection process. This is located on the Arrowhead High School website (arrowheadschoools.org>>Counseling>>Enroll).

If you live out of district and will be applying for Open Enrollment, follow the same procedures listed above. IN ADDITION, you will need to apply online at www.dpi.wi.gov/open-enrollment which opens on Monday, Feb. 2 and closes on April 30, 2025. If this step is not completed, you will be removed from our data base.

- ❑ To pick classes review the **GREEN Freshmen Course Selection Worksheet**. Put your course selections in the Rough Draft spaces provided on the back page to help in planning out both 1st & 2nd semesters. You will need between 14 and 16 credits.

The **2026-27 Arrowhead High School Academic Course Guide** can be found online for graduation credit requirements and all course descriptions. (arrowheadschoools.org >> Academics>>Academic & Career Options>>Course Info & Selection).

- ❑ If you are interested in summer school classes, review the **YELLOW Summer School Course Selection Worksheet**. Summer school course selections are first come first serve, but will stay open through June 15th, space permitting. There is NOT a waiting list, so keep checking in Skyward for availability.
- ❑ Once you have planned out your classes, use the **PINK Course Selection Online Directions** sheet to request your selected courses for both regular and summer school.

9th grade Course Selection BEGINS on Wednesday, Feb. 11th at 5:00 p.m.

Regular classes CLOSE on Friday, February 13th at 5:00 p.m.

Summer classes stay open through Monday, June 15th – space permitting
