Use the Pink Course Selection Online Directions sheet to request your selected courses which begins on Wednesday, February 7th at 5:00 p.m. and closes on Friday, February 9 th at 5:00 p.m.

Go back to the Pink Course Selection Online Directions sheet and halfway down the page you will see the "Summer School Course Selection Online Directions". Follow these steps to select your summer school courses. This begins on Wed. Feb. 7 th at 5:00 p.m as well, but stays open through June 7th, space permitting. There is not a waiting list for summer courses, keep checking in Skyward for availability.
