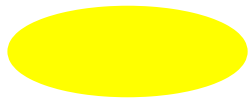

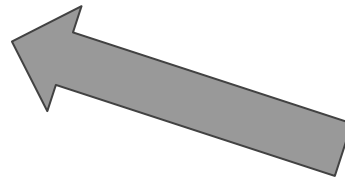

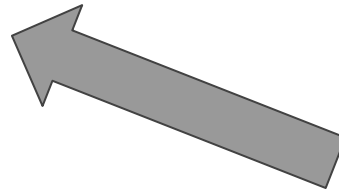

## Step 4: Math

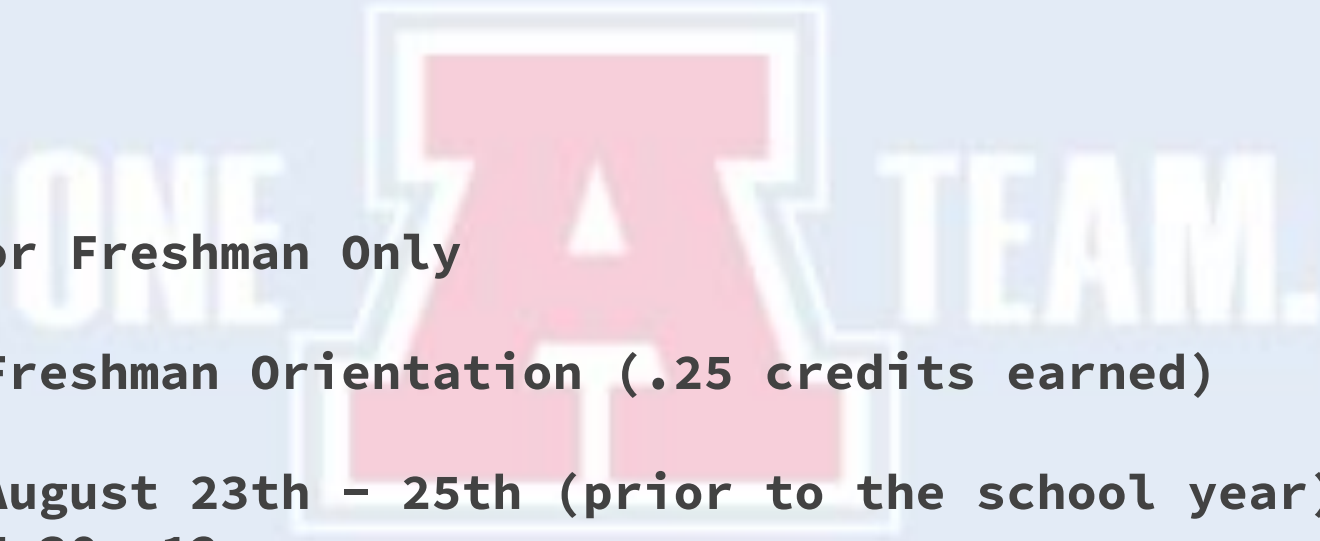
# SUMMER SCHOOL
