Courses with ONE number next to it are a one semester course and count as **1** credit. You only need to enter the one course number (ex: 002957 2D Design).
- Lunch and study hall(s) will be added later by school staff.
- Courses with a prerequisite are indicated with an *. Refer to the ***Course Guide*** for details.
- Courses meeting at North Campus are indicated with a (NC).
- Be sure to request **ALL CORE CLASSES**: English, Math, Science and Social Studies.
- **YOU MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF 14 OR A MAX OF 16 CREDITS IN YOUR COURSE REQUESTS.**
