- Please remember that the event is only open to Arrowhead Juniors & Seniors.

Arrowhead Juniors & Seniors are allowed ONE guest.

- Guests from other schools are welcome to attend, but must be 19 or UNDER and must fill out the required Guest Form online at the time of purchase.
- 9th & 10th grade students may attend only as guests of a Junior or Senior.

Please carefully review the important information below regarding details for the upcoming ticket sales.

TICKET SALES:

- Tickets will be available for purchase ON-LINE from Monday, April 21 - Thursday, May 1, 2025 at 11:59 PM.
 - **Absolutely no tickets will be sold outside of this purchase window.**
- Tickets are \$55 each plus a Vanco processing fee.
 - **Prom tickets are non-refundable for any reason.**
- Only AHS juniors and seniors are allowed to purchase prom tickets.
- Maximum number of tickets allowed to be purchased is 2 per person.
- Students will receive a QR code for each ticket that is purchased. We suggest downloading this QR code or taking a screenshot so it is readily available at Prom. (Wifi access at prom is uncertain)
- When purchasing a ticket, students will be asked to identify any dietary restrictions. Most dietary restrictions are already accommodated through the variety of food options available at Prom.

IMPORTANT!

- **AHS students are required to present their ticket QR code** (and that of their guest if applicable) **and their AHS student ID** in order to enter prom.

- QR codes will be scanned upon entrance. Each code may only be used once.

BRINGING A NON-ARROWHEAD GUEST?

All guests must be 19 years of age or under. Guests must present a photo ID. AHS students must fill out a [GUEST FORM \(linked here\)](#) for their non-Arrowhead guest by midnight on Friday, May 2nd. *Note: You MUST be logged into your Arrowhead gmail account to access the guest form.*

Arrowhead staff, teachers, administrators and Waukesha Sheriff's Department Deputies will be supervising prom.
