Letters of recommendation are an important component of college and scholarship applications. Students are encouraged to follow the steps below:

1. Provide a copy of the completed Senior Profile - available as a word document using the school website or in the counseling office.
2. Consider scheduling a meeting with your teacher, counselor, etc. to discuss the request for a letter
3. Allow a minimum of two weeks advanced notice.
4. Provide clear details including website to visit for online recommendations, forms to be completed, etc.
5. Follow up with clarifications, reminders, thank you note, etc.
