 Re: Changes to students' schedules due to state testing

Dear Arrowhead Families,

Wisconsin statute requires schools to assess students in 9th, 10th, and 11th grades. There are three assessments (ACT, ACT WORKKEYS and ACT ASPIRE) administered that will interrupt our regular daily schedule. Why the interruption to the regular schedule?

We want to provide students with a quality testing environment. Our goal is to minimize distractions, interruptions, or other testing irregularities by reducing the amount of students in the buildings. It is important to note that in order to administer 570 or more assessments to each grade level, teaching staff must be available to proctor and classroom space is needed for students to take the tests. Note that the "ASPIRE" test for Grades 9 and 10 is a computer-based assessment which requires the class to be split in half to accommodate students' needs for school-supported computers and software. In the chart below, you can see the dates in which your child will be testing, in school, or off.
