## Arrowhead Union High School District COVID-19 Participation Notice & Personal Health Statement 2021-2022



The national, state, and local health authorities (Center for Disease Control, WI Department of Health Services, and Waukesha County Public Health Department) confirm that COVID-19 continues to persist and may be contracted primarily through person-to-person airborne spread. The Arrowhead Union High School District will continue to hold school including curricular and co-curricular activities and non-school activities within our campus buildings and grounds and off our campus (e.g. field trips, student transportation/busing) during the time period of this disease pandemic.

Arrowhead cannot and will not guarantee there will be no exposure to COVID-19 and other diseases while on our campus or while participating in school-based functions off our campus. Students, family members, staff members, and other members of the public, merely by participating in Arrowhead events and activities on and off our campus, are acknowledging that they understand the risks associated with participating in Arrowhead events and activities on and off our campus. Arrowhead may offer strategies to reduce the health risk factors related to COVID-19 and other similar diseases, but individuals are responsible for their own health safety while participating in all Arrowhead activities, on or off our campus.

To reduce the risk of contracting and/or spreading COVID-19 and other similar diseases, participants in all Arrowhead activities are advised and requested to implement the following <u>Personal Health Risk</u> <u>Mitigation Strategies</u>:

- Stay home when sick.
- Conduct daily self-check health screening questions. If experiencing symptoms noted below, consider contacting your physician.
  - Have you been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19?
  - Are you experiencing a cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, or sore throat?
  - Have you had a fever of 100.4 or above?
  - Have you had a new loss of taste or smell?
  - Have you had muscle pain or chills?
  - Have you had a new headache?
  - Have you had nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea?
- The wearing of facial masks is optional for students and staff while on campus.
- COVID-19 vaccinations are optional for students and staff.
- Proper hand care is encouraged- thorough washing, sanitizer and refrain from touching the face.
- Respiratory etiquette is encouraged cover coughs and sneezes with tissue and throw away.
